

# *Immerse Your Students in History at the Old Treasury Building*



The Old Treasury Building is a unique resource for students and teachers. A magnificent gold rush building, it reflects the growth of 'Marvellous Melbourne' and changing life in the city. Our VCE Australian History program draws on key onsite exhibitions where students will consider various factors that influenced European attitudes to First Nations people by examining primary and secondary documents. They will reflect on the Gold Rush population increase, and how various members of the community were treated at the time.

In addition to our excellent and informative tours, the Old Treasury Building's website hosts a wide variety of well researched online exhibitions.

Tours cost \$11 per student, the minimum number of students in a session is 10; the maximum is 50. Tours are allocated in one hour blocks.
